Course Description:

This course has the same requirements as the AP Drawing Portfolio course (see below). Students, however, may use photography and digital media in their 2D Design Portfolio.

This program is intended for highly motivated students committed to serious study in art. In this course, the student will produce a portfolio with a minimum of 15 original works. The portfolio explores practice, revision and experimentation of art making. Students may work in a variety of mediums including photography, drawing, painting and mixed media..

Students are encouraged to take the AP exam. The AP test must be taken if a student wants the opportunity to earn college credit.

This course meets the CSU and the UC Visual and Performing Arts requirement.

Recommended Skills:

Must be able to make artwork independently. Must have developed beginner art skills in all mediums. Must be self starting and confident in art skills.
