FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

Do I need to preregister?

- Registration is open to the first 75 PAID participants for each location. Registrants must pay a \$250-\$275 non-refundable registration fee.

What can I bring to the facility?

- Please bring anything you may need (i.e. water, basketball shorts, towels, ankle brace, extra socks, energy bars). **SNEAKERS ARE MANDATORY**

Are spectators allowed to watch the Tryout?

- No, we are not allowing spectators at either tryout session. This includes personal photographers/ videographers, agents, family and friends.

What is the format of the Tryout?

- Evaluation by the Brooklyn Nets and Long Island Nets staff
- Skill work
- Game play

Will there be trainers or medical personnel onsite in case of injuries?

- Yes, there will be a trainer and medical services on-site.

Do I need an agent to participate?

- No, you do not.

What happens if I sign up and cannot attend? Will my money be refunded?

- No, the registration fee is NON-REFUNDABLE.

Will I be reimbursed for any travel costs?

- No, there will not be reimbursement for any travel costs

What do I need to bring to check-in? Do I need to bring an ID?

- Yes, you must have a valid photo ID to check in.

Do I need to sign a waiver?

- Yes, all participants are required to sign a waiver. You will fill this out during your online registration.

Will there be any transportation to and from the event?

- No, you must arrange your own transportation.

Will the Long Island Nets provide a hotel if necessary?

- No, the Long Island Nets will not provide or arrange any hotel accommodations.

Who is eligible to play in the NBA G League?

In order to be submitted as a Local Tryout Player, the player must: (a) not be considered a Prospect (as defined below), (b) not be an International Player (as defined below), or (c) have been eligible for and gone through an NBA Draft.

A. A “Prospect” is any player who: has been an NBA Draft pick; has been under contract with an NBA team at any time prior to NBA G League opening rosters being set (5:00 P.M. (ET) on November 7, 2024); was a Division I All-American, or a Division I All-Conference performer (in the following conferences only Big East, Big Ten, Big 12, SEC, PAC 12, ACC, AAC, A10, or Mountain West), in the 2022-23 or 2023-24 season (“All-American” is defined as a first, second or third team performer as selected by the Associated Press, USA Today or National Basketball Coaches Association and “All-Conference” is defined as first, second or third team performer as selected by the Conference); played in an NBA Summer League game in 2023 or 2024; received end-of-season NBA G League recognition (including individual NBA G League awards like Most Valuable Player, Rookie of the Year, Defensive Player of the Year and Most Improved Player of the Year, but not including a Sportsmanship Award, and any All-NBA G League Teams) for the 2022-23 or 2023-24 seasons; attended the Portsmouth Invitational Tournament in 2024; attended the 2023 or 2024 NBA Draft Combine or NBA G League Elite Camp; or has been tendered a contract by the League for the upcoming season.

B. An “International Player” is a player who was born, and resides outside of, the United States or Canada, has never enrolled in a high school in the United States or Canada, and has never played in any exhibition, preseason, regular season, or postseason college basketball game in the United States or Canada.

REGISTRATION FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE – NO EXCEPTIONS
