



The Title Should be Accurately Describing the Content

(Should not be written as sentence, not more than 15 words, brief, written by capitalizing each word)

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ABSTRACT

A paragraph of abstract with 250 words or less, containing the purpose of the research, the methods, the findings of the research, using 10-pt font size.

Keywords: consists of a minimum 3 words and maximum of 7 italicized words or phrases and separated with a comma.

Introduction

The draft consists of one column on A4 paper. The margin text from the left and top are 2.5cm, right and bottom are 2 cm, is written in Microsoft Word, 1.5 spaced, Segoe UI font, 11,5 pt. The whole draft should consist of between 4000 – 8000 words.

All introductions should be presented in the forms of paragraphs, not pointers, and with the proportion of 15–20% of the whole article length.

The introduction should provide the following information (with or without a subsection):

a. Background and Objective(s)

This section provides a clear background of the research that indicates the importance and the relevance of the research area. The gap in the previous research and the objectives of the research are also included in this section. Preview of the article can also be unfolded in this section.

b. Theoretical Framework/Literature Review

The elaborated literature reviews as well as the main frameworks of the research are presented here. Present the well-explained relationship between the research and what has been done in the research area. It is also expected to describe the adopted theory to analyze the data and elucidate the findings. It is highly suggested to refer to the current research papers and minimize reviewing the undergraduate and or graduate theses.

c. Research Problems

It contains questions or statements about research concerns formulated based on the research gap (optional).

Methods

The research method is written in paragraphs with subsections consisting of Research Design, Population and Sample or Participant of the Research, Instruments, and Data Analysis. In qualitative study it is suggested to explain the model to be used in analyzing the data.

Result and Discussion

This section combines the findings and the discussion of the research. The findings should be clear, concise, and unbiased. It should be written objectively and factually, and without expressing personal opinion. Any tables, charts, graphs, and other figures, should confirm the APA format (<https://apastyle.apa.org/style-grammar-guidelines/tables-figures>).

For Tables, the title size is 11 and the content size is 10. Number the tables subsequently throughout your article and the title is written above the table.

For Figures, the title size is 11 and the content size (if any) is 10. Number the figures subsequently throughout your article and the title is written below the figure.

The discussion should interpret and explain the meaning of the findings. It is suggested to highlight the importance of the research and how it can contribute to understanding the research problem within the area of the research.

Conclusion

In this section, it is highly suggested to go beyond merely restating the findings of the research. This section intends to show the readers what they can obtain after reading the research.

Limitations of your study should be addressed. Here it can also propose recommendations for a course of action or suggest useful areas for further research.

ACKNOWLEDGMENTS (optional)

Give credit to funding bodies and departments that have been of help during the project, for instance by supporting it financially.

You are required to list all sources mentioned in the article and you should not list other sources that are not mentioned there. The references are in alphabetical order and left-aligned.
