Exhibit Title/Header Image/Overview:

Synthesize the information about your tribe by providing an exhibit title, header image, and a well written introduction to the exhibit connecting the items curated to the history and culture of the tribe.

Exhibit Items:

You will need to curate a **minimum of 8** and a **maximum of 16 items** in your digital exhibit, representing **at least 8 of the categories researched**. For each of the items in the exhibit, you must include a hyperlink to the item, an image of the item, a title for the item, and a brief description of how the item highlights a specific aspect of the tribe's history, culture, and/or contemporary life. Mix it up: Text, images, video, audio, interactive, etc. Vary your selection! Evaluate your resources to ensure if they are reliable, relevant, and accurate.
