1. Overview

We value your privacy. This Privacy Policy explains what data we collect, how it is used, and your rights regarding your information when using our mobile game *Slash of Sword 2 - Rebellious Jousting*

By using the game, you agree to this Privacy Policy.

2. Data We Collect

We do not collect personal information directly.

However, we may collect non-personal data automatically, including:

- Device type and model
- Screen resolution
- Operating system version
- Language preferences
- Android Advertising ID (for Android devices)

This data is collected for analytics and to improve gameplay and ad experience.

3. Advertising and Third-Party Services

Our game uses third-party advertising networks:

- Google AdMob
- Unity Ads
- ironSource LevelPlay (Mediation)

These networks may collect data to show relevant ads, limit repetitive ads, detect fraud, and measure performance. Data collected may include:

- Advertising identifiers (e.g., AAID on Android; IDFA on iOS where permitted)
- IP address (used for approximate location and security)
- Device information (model, OS, language)
- Ad events (impressions, clicks)

We do not intentionally collect direct identifiers; ad partners process data for ad delivery/measurement.

Each provider handles data in accordance with its own privacy policies:

General location (city and country): We do not collect or access precise location (GPS). However, our third-party advertising partners may infer an approximate location (such as city and country) from the device's IP address to provide ads, comply with legal requirements, prevent fraud, and measure ad performance.

AppTrackingTransparency (ATT) / IDFA (iOS)

On iOS, the App follows Apple's AppTrackingTransparency framework. The device's advertising identifier (IDFA) is accessed **only if** the user grants permission via the ATT prompt. If the user does not grant permission, the App does not access IDFA, and advertising partners are requested to serve **non-personalized / limited** ads where supported.

4. GDPR and CCPA Compliance

If you are located in the European Union (GDPR) or California (CCPA), you have the right to:

- Request access to data collected about you
- Request data deletion (where applicable)
- Opt out of personalized advertising

You can manage your consent preferences through the consent prompt shown at first launch.
