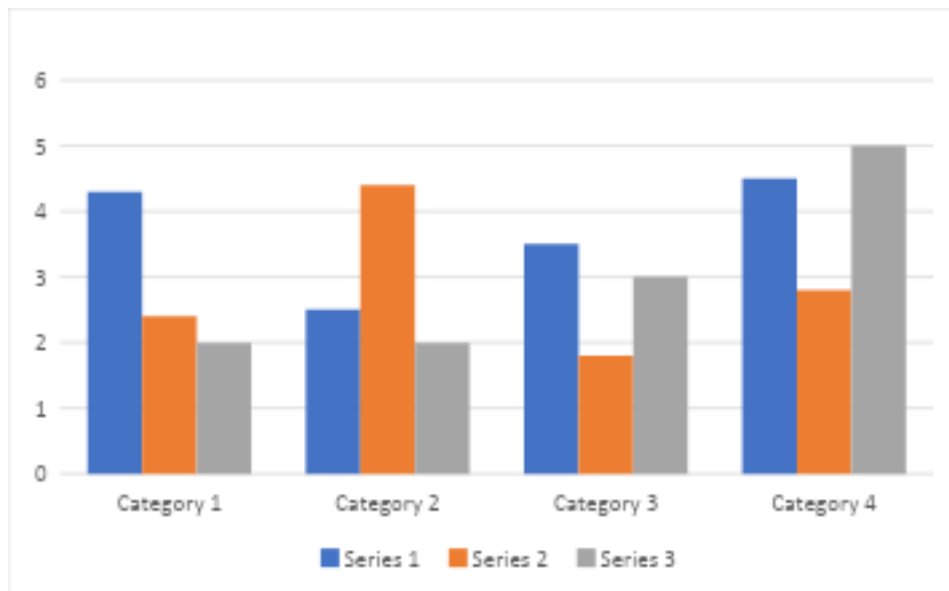


Diagram 1. Graphic Title
