

Cactus Cup 2026 Code of Conduct & Event Policies

All volunteers, competitors, coaches, and spectators are expected to adhere to our Cactus Cup Code of Conduct. Failure to abide by our Code of Conduct may result in expulsion without reimbursement from the event.

- 1. All participants must sign our liability waiver before participating. This will be done at the registration desk.
- All competitors will adhere to the rules as they apply to the tournaments in which they are registered.
- Competitors shall not compete under the influence of drugs or alcohol. This may include
 prescription or over the counter medications that may alter a competitor's motor control or
 cognitive function in a way that is unsafe for physical activity or handling weapons in a
 competitive environment.
- 4. Mordhau KdF LLC, and Cactus Cup, shall uphold a zero tolerance policy against discrimination on the basis of race, color, religion (creed), gender, gender expression, national origin, disability, marital status, sexual orientation, profession, or military status, in any of our activities or operations. There will be zero tolerance for discriminatory language or conduct of any kind from or towards volunteer staff, spectators, or competitors. Unwanted sexual advances, solicitations, or harassment will likewise not be tolerated.
- 5. The nature of our tournament software, HEMAscorecard, is public. Misuse of the publicly available information to intentionally cause harm, harass, or disrupt Cactus Cup, or any of its volunteers or participants, is explicitly forbidden.
- 6. Filming and photography is allowed, however, event organizers retain the right to deny filming or photography of this private event at any time should it become disruptive. Please ensure filming equipment does not obstruct tournament staff from their duties. Please be courteous of people not wanting to be filmed or have photos taken, especially with minors who are under 18.
- 7. Outside food and drink (with the exception of water) is not permitted in the venue. Please do not bring snacks into the venue, there are plenty of food options within the hotel.
- 8. Refunds will not be given for cancellations made after June 15th, 2026 at 11:59PM MT(Phoenix). Refunds shall not be given in the event of disqualification or Code of Conduct violations.
- 9. Safety concerns shall be reported to event staff immediately.
