

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION IN “SPLOT SŁONECZNY” EVENTS

1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1.1. These Terms and Conditions set out the rules for participation in events organized under the “Splot Słoneczny” brand.

1.2. These Terms and Conditions apply to all persons present at the Event, regardless of the basis upon which they entered the Event premises.

1.3. Purchasing a ticket, receiving an invitation, entering the Event premises or remaining on the Event premises constitutes acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.

1.4. The Organizers reserve the right to modify the program, schedule, operating hours of individual zones, attractions, artists, performers and other elements of the Event without any obligation to refund the ticket price.

1.5. The Organizers reserve the right to cancel the Event or any part thereof due to circumstances beyond their control, including but not limited to safety concerns, force majeure events or decisions issued by competent public authorities.

2. EVENT VENUE AND SAFETY RULES

2.1. The Event takes place at Tunelowa 2A, Warsaw, Poland, and in adjacent areas made available to participants by the Organizers.

2.2. The Event venue is located in the immediate vicinity of railway infrastructure and industrial facilities.

2.3. Participants are required to exercise particular caution while moving around the Event venue.

2.4. Participants must comply with safety signage, announcements issued by the Organizers and instructions given by security personnel and emergency services.

2.5. Entry into technical areas, railway areas, service zones, storage areas, organizer facilities and any other restricted areas marked as inaccessible to participants is strictly prohibited.

2.6. Climbing on technical structures, infrastructure elements, fences, containers, roofs, vehicles or any other objects not intended for participant use is prohibited.

2.7. Participants attend and remain at the Event entirely at their own risk and responsibility.

3. ADMISSION RULES

3.1. Admission to the Event is permitted only upon presentation of a valid ticket, invitation or other document authorizing entry.

3.2. Tickets are non-refundable except where mandatory provisions of applicable law provide otherwise.

3.3. The purchase of a ticket, including through online sales channels or other distribution methods, does not constitute an unconditional guarantee of admission to the Event. The Organizers reserve the right to refuse admission or remove a participant from the Event in circumstances provided for in these Terms and Conditions, applicable law, or where justified by safety, public order or operational considerations. In such cases, the participant shall not be entitled to a refund unless mandatory provisions of applicable law provide otherwise.

3.4. Leaving the Event venue results in the loss of the right to re-enter using the same ticket. The Organizers do not guarantee re-entry once a participant has left the Event premises.

3.5. The Organizers reserve the right to refuse admission without providing any reason.

3.6. In particular, admission may be refused to persons who:

- a) are under the influence of alcohol,
- b) are under the influence of narcotics or psychoactive substances,
- c) behave aggressively,
- d) violate these Terms and Conditions,
- e) pose a threat to other participants,
- f) refuse to undergo security screening,
- g) possess prohibited items,
- h) may disrupt the proper course of the Event.

3.7. The Organizers and security personnel acting on their behalf may conduct inspections of persons, clothing, bags, luggage and any items brought onto the Event premises.

4. MINORS

4.1. Persons under the age of 18 may attend the Event only under the continuous supervision of a parent, legal guardian or another person authorized by them until 19:00.

4.2. Parents and guardians bear full responsibility for the conduct, safety and actions of minors under their care.

4.3. The Organizers do not provide childcare services or supervision of minors.

4.4. The sale or service of alcoholic beverages to persons under the age of 18 is strictly prohibited.

5. PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES

5.1. Bringing outside alcoholic beverages, non-alcoholic beverages, food or other food products onto the Event premises is prohibited unless expressly permitted by the Organizers.

5.2. Possessing, using, selling, distributing or making available narcotics, psychoactive substances or any other substances prohibited by law is strictly forbidden.

5.3. Bringing weapons, ammunition, explosives, pyrotechnics, flammable substances, corrosive materials or any other dangerous items onto the Event premises is prohibited.

5.4. Damaging infrastructure, equipment or property located on the Event premises is prohibited.

5.5. Littering the Event premises is prohibited.

5.6. Conducting commercial, promotional, advertising, solicitation or fundraising activities without the prior written consent of the Organizers is prohibited.

5.7. Disrupting the Event or interfering with the enjoyment of the Event by other participants is prohibited.

5.8. Aggressive, dangerous, discriminatory or otherwise inappropriate conduct violating the rights of other participants is prohibited.

5.9. Bringing or operating bicycles, scooters, electric scooters, skateboards, roller skates, personal transportation devices or similar equipment on the Event premises is prohibited unless expressly authorized by the Organizers.

5.10. Bringing personal sound systems, loudspeakers, megaphones, musical instruments or any devices capable of disrupting the Event or interfering with the experience of other participants is prohibited.

5.11. Bringing animals, including dogs, onto the event premises is prohibited.

6. RIGHTS OF THE ORGANIZERS AND SECURITY PERSONNEL

6.1. The Organizers and security personnel acting on their behalf are entitled to issue binding instructions relating to safety, order and the proper conduct of the Event.

6.2. Participants must immediately comply with instructions issued by the Organizers, security personnel, emergency services, Police, Fire Brigade and other authorized authorities.

6.3. The Organizers may remove from the Event any person who violates these Terms and Conditions or whose conduct may endanger safety, public order, the reputation of the Organizers or the proper course of the Event.

6.4. The Organizers may remove from the Event any person whose presence is deemed undesirable.

6.5. Removal from the Event does not entitle the participant to any ticket refund, compensation or reimbursement.

6.6. The Organizers may refuse re-entry to any participant who has been removed from the Event.

7. IMAGE RIGHTS AND EVENT RECORDING

7.1. The Event is photographed and recorded using audio and video equipment.

7.2. By attending the Event, participants grant their irrevocable consent to the free-of-charge recording, use and distribution of their image and likeness.

7.3. Such consent includes use by the Organizers, sponsors, partners, contractors and entities cooperating with the Organizers.

7.4. Images and recordings may be used for promotional, advertising, marketing, informational, press, archival and documentary purposes.

7.5. Images and recordings may be used worldwide, without territorial or time limitations, including on websites, social media platforms, streaming services, television broadcasts, printed materials and advertising materials.

7.6. Participants waive any claims arising from the use of their image and likeness in accordance with these Terms and Conditions.

8. LIABILITY

8.1. Participation in the Event is entirely at the participant's own risk.

8.2. The Organizers shall not be liable for the loss, theft, misplacement or damage of unattended personal property.

8.3. The Organizers shall not be liable for property damage, loss of profits or any other losses suffered by participants unless resulting directly from the intentional misconduct of the Organizers.

8.4. The Organizers shall not be liable for the actions of other participants.

8.5. The Organizers shall not be liable for injuries, damages or other consequences resulting from failure to comply with these Terms and Conditions, safety rules or instructions issued by security personnel.

8.6. Participants shall be fully liable for any damage caused by themselves, persons under their supervision or animals under their control.
