Question 5

Have you ever experienced any form of racial discrimination while shopping? Explain. The discrimination can be something you experienced or something you observed.

Question 6

Have you or someone close to you ever experienced racial slurs, racial jokes, or exclusions from peers based on ethnicity or skin color? Explain how it made you feel and how you handled it.

(You do not need to explain the situation, just how you dealt with the experience)

Question 7

Do you remember a time when you had misinterpreted stereotypes about a person that you encountered? Explain why you think you made these assumptions.

(You do not need to explain the situation, just why you think you had these stereotypes)

Question 8

Stereotypes and labels can have far-reaching and harmful effects on an individual, influencing their self-esteem, opportunities, and overall well-being. Explain how stereotyping affects individuals who experience these negative labels.

Question 9

The appearance components of stereotypes often act as powerful triggers for people to use negative labels, reinforcing preconceived notions about individuals or groups. Explain why you think people use negative labels and allow these preconceived stereotypes to continue.
