

Dual Credit: 2026-2027

Course Description: Christian School of York partners with Harrisburg Area Community College (HACC), Messiah University, Lancaster Bible College (LBC), and Houghton University for Dual Credit. Juniors and seniors can earn college credit while still enrolled in high school. Dual Credit can be taken in person by traveling to the college or taken virtually. Students that take Dual Credit can earn CSY credit and college credit. Students will receive the same grade and credit on the CSY transcript that is posted on their college transcript. The course is not weighted, and will not impact the students GPA.

- *Normally Semester Course - check with your college*
- *Prerequisite/Requirements:*
 - *Students will need administrator and parents approval.*
 - *Students must have a minimum GPA of 3.5 or higher.*
 - *If the student selects a non-Christian affiliated college, the student will be required to complete one Christian Worldview project on the course topic. The specifics of this project will require advanced approval by the Upper School Principal.*
 - *Students will have to complete the application process before taking the college course as dual credit. If the student does not complete the application the course will follow Dual Enrollment guidelines.*
 - ***Please return the application to Mrs. Zelinske. The form will not be accepted after the college course starts.***
 - *Students who are applying for Dual Credit must take at least one CSY course per semester.*
 - *Once students receive their grade, students will have to provide CSY's Guidance Counselor with an official transcript from the college before **Feb. 1 (Fall Semester) or June 15 (Spring Semester)**. Failure to submit the transcript by the designated deadline will result in an Incomplete (INC) for the course.*
 - *Students must be in 10th to 12th grade*
 - *Dual credit courses can be any type of credit (math, literature, science, etc.)*
- *Level: Academic*
- *Credit: 1 - This credit can count as any subject besides Bible, approved by Mr. Hortman and Mrs. Zelinske*

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Important Notes:

- Please remember that CSY does not provide early graduation to students.
- Students must complete all four years in the upper/high school.
- CSY does not provide discount tuition for students that are taking any college courses onsite or off site.
- Please know that one college course, regardless of the college credits, is the equivalent of one CSY academic credit.
- This policy applies to students graduating in the year 2026 and after.
