The PCM will happen on Sunday, Sept. 21 at the United Nations Headquarters, which is located on the east side of Midtown on 1st Avenue between 42nd and 48th Street. The People's Climate Train arrives at NYC's Penn Station at approximately 6:30 pm on Thursday, Sept 18. PLEASE NOTE: we will update this list as the weekend draws closer, however hotel rates will only increase from when we wrote them. We strongly encourage you to plan and book your accommodations asap, as hotels are already booking up for that weekend.

- **Booking instructions:** To reserve a room at this rate, call Kelly the manager directly at (201) 250-2038 and tell her the top secret promo code: "people's climate train" -- NOTE: reservations at this rate MUST be made by August 18th for the nights of and between Sept. 18-20.
- **Transportation:** It takes about 1 hr to get to UN Plaza. NJ Transit bus #129 picks you up 2.5 blocks away from hotel and takes you Port Authority in NYC (22 minute ride). Port Authority (42nd and 8th) is about a 25 minute walk (1.3 miles) from the United Nations (although one could take a train, bus or cab if they desired).
