#### Ally

The <u>Ally</u> tool is automatically available in your Blackboard courses for students to download machine translated <u>alternative document formats</u> in over 70 languages. Students can also access the Ally File Transformer on Blackboard's <u>Assist</u> page to translate their own Word, PowerPoint, PDF, and HTML files. **No** additional work is required from the instructor for students to benefit from Ally translations.

### **Blackboard Profile - Language Preference Setting**

A student may <u>customize their Blackboard profile</u> to set their <u>Language</u> system setting to view Blackboard's navigational elements in English, Spanish, or Arabic. This setting only applies to Blackboard's base navigation; it does not translate course content!

## **Google Translate**

Although we do not have a comprehensive integration for translating all types of content shared within and outside of Blackboard, students may use <u>Google Translate Chrome extension</u> to translate individual web pages. <u>See these instructions</u>.

## **YuJa Video Caption Translations**

Faculty who create and upload their own videos to the <u>YuJa Video Platform</u> can expect their videos to be auto-captioned in English. After the English captions are available, faculty can <u>request caption translations in alternative languages</u>. Once this is complete, students can view the video with the translated closed captions.
