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- Overview of SBHA extension use case status and interview/survey questionnaires of education/training provider stakeholders. Invited attendees to complete survey.
 - o Michael Sessa suggested adding CAEL and WGU to the survey participants
 - DESM status - learning what the tool is doing now and what improvements can be made going forward
 - Collaboration stories - the purpose of DTSN is to build bridges and develop cross standards solutions. We want to advance the use of standards by celebrating stories of integrators of data standards.
 - o Other work that is happening - Michael sessa brought up the gender identity task force with multiple initiatives related to how data might be stored related to gender at birth, gender identity, and sexual orientation – Currently, standards are not being developed but this is a topic that is being explored. Down the road if standards are developed it is likely that PESC and Data Standards United would be involved.
 - o Michael Sessa also brought up micro credentials and experiential learning standards
 - Jim mentioned the importance of leveraging other work that has been done and open discussions on new initiatives
 - Need to address the problem of capturing verifiable employment data – JEDX offers better ways
