It is a requirement that every FFDC Educator and staff member have both the Alerts channel and their group's FCR channel so notifications come through. The other channels can be muted, at that Educator's or staff member's discretion, however you should still be viewing those other channels regularly.

Every staff member and Educator must be actively contributing to their FCR group's critical reflection for a **minimum of 10 minutes per week**. That adds up to 130 minutes, or 2 hours and 10 minutes per Educator across the quarter. With at least 6 members of each FCR group, that adds up to at least 13 hours per FCR group per quarter.
