

# 12 High

## Order of Operations

### Materials Needed:

4 Dice  
Colored Markers  
12 High Game Board

### Number of Players: 2 (or 2 teams)

### Object of the Game:

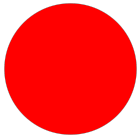
To be the first team to consecutively create all target numbers.

### How to Play:

- Players (or teams) take turns rolling four dice.
- Both teams use all of the numbers rolled to create an expression using any operation (+, -, x, ÷). The goal is to create an expression that equals each consecutive target number on the playing board, starting with 3. Players may use parentheses in their expressions. **Only one target number can be formed on each turn.**
- If a player successfully creates an expression that equals the target number, they will move their marker to cover that number. If a player cannot create an expression that equals the target number, they try again with that same target number on the next roll of the dice.
- The winner is the first player or team to move their marker down the board to 12.

\* There are many variations/modifications for this game, such as playing with more or less dice, a deck of cards (using Aces (1) to 9), or having teams/players use 10 markers and create one target number per play but in any order.
