STUDENT PHONE/ELECTRONIC DEVICES POLICY & GUIDELINES

Phones/electronic devices are not to be used during school. Every student will be assigned a personal Yondr Pouch. While the Yondr Pouch is considered school property, it is each student's responsibility to bring their Pouch with them to school every day and keep it in good working condition. We encourage families to have students leave gaming devices and other electronics at home, as they are not permitted at school.

DAILY PROCESS: As students **arrive at school**, they will:

- 1) Turn their phone off.
- 2) Place their phone/all devices (earbuds/smart watches) inside their pouch before entering campus.
- 3) Store their pouch in the locked position in their backpack for the day.

At the end of the day, students will unlock their pouch, remove their phone, and secure the pouch in the locked position before placing it in their backpack. **Pouches are required at school every day, regardless of whether the student has a phone or not.**

***Students arriving late or leaving early will pouch/unpouch their phones in the Main Office.

VIOLATIONS: Pouch Damage / Lost Pouch / Using Phone During School

If a student damages their pouch or is caught using their phone, Administration will collect the student's pouch/phone and call home. Repercussions for damaged pouches or unauthorized phone use will include:

1st offense: device confiscated – returned to parent only – **parent called by administration and cell phone will be checked into the office each morning for 2 weeks and receive a modified structured day.**

2nd offense: device confiscated - returned to parent only - **parent called by administration, student will receive Saturday school along with cell phone checked into the office each morning for the remainder of the school year.**

*****Further infractions beyond the 2nd offense or not following school policy can result in further loss of privileges such as, not attending school events/field trips/dances, etc...**

\$30 fee for a replacement pouch

Examples of pouch damage include:

- Bent pin
- Ripped fabric
- Deep scratches on the lock exterior + green ring
- Intentional pen marks on the inside or outside of the pouch
- Pin and button not fully recessing due to pin damage

Forgotten Pouches: If a student forgets their pouch, they must check their phone into the front office for the remainder of the school day. It is a violation of school policy to have a phone on campus that is not locked in the assigned pouch. The phone will be returned to the student at dismissal. If a student repeatedly forgets their pouch, it will be considered lost, and Administration will call home to remind parents of the policy. Please refer to the Lost Pouch policy above for further details.

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Teléfono celular / AirPod / Póliza de dispositivos electrónicos

Los teléfonos celulares no se deben usar durante la escuela. A cada estudiante se le asigna una funda Yondr personal. Mientras que el Yondr Pouch es considerado propiedad de la escuela, es la responsabilidad de cada estudiante traer su funda con ellos a la escuela todos los días y mantenerla en buena condición.

PROCESO DIARIO A medida que los estudiantes **lleguen a la escuela**, ellos:

- 1) Apagan su teléfono celular.
- 2) Colocan su teléfono celular/ todos dispositivos electrónicos dentro de el estuche y se asegura frente al personal de la escuela
- 3) Se guarda su funda cerrada en la mochila durante el día

Al final del día, los estudiantes abrirán su funda, quitarán su teléfono, cerrarán su funda y la pondrán en su mochila. **Se requiere que los estudiantes traigan su pouch a la escuela todos los días, tengan teléfono o no.**

*Los estudiantes que lleguen tarde o salgan temprano abren sus fundas en la **[Oficina]**.

VIOLACIONES Daño de la funda / Funda perdida / Usando el celular durante la escuela

Si un estudiante daña su funda o si se miran usando su teléfono, la Administración recogerá el teléfono celular / funda y llamará a casa.

Repercusiones por daño materiales o no autorizado uso de teléfono incluirán:

1.ª infracción: dispositivo confiscado; se devuelve sólo al padre; el padre llamado por la administración y el teléfono celular será entregado en la oficina todas las mañanas durante 2 semanas y recibirá un día estructurado modificado.

2da infracción: dispositivo confiscado - devuelto solo al padre -el padre llamado por la administración, el estudiante recibirá clase de sábado. El teléfono celular se entregará en la oficina todas las mañanas durante el resto del año escolar.

*****Otras infracciones más allá de la segunda infracción o por no seguir la póliza escolar pueden resultar en una mayor pérdida de privilegios, como no asistir a excursiones/bailes, etc.**

\$30 fee for a replacement pouch

Ejemplos de daños incluyen

- Danos al pasador
- Tela rompida
- Rayones profundos/ daños al la cerradura y el anillo verde
- Marcas intencionales de plumón o pluma dentro del estuche
- No se cierra completamente el estuche debido a daños en el pasador o botón

Bolsas olvidadas: si un estudiante olvida su bolsa, se le retirará el teléfono y la administración llamará a su casa para recordarles a los padres sobre esta póliza. El teléfono se devolverá al estudiante a la salida. Si el estudiante olvida su bolsa constantemente, se considerará perdida. Consulte la póliza de bolsas pérdidas.

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
