

WAYS TO STUDY

Suggestions from 5th graders for 5th graders

1. Be sure to write down the dates of upcoming assignments or tests on a calendar
2. Study a little bit every night, ahead of time even, if it's not part of the homework assignment (this INCLUDES weekends!)
3. Check homework assignments, study guides, vocabulary cards and practice tests that can be used to go over material
4. Have a "study buddy" (parent, older sibling, classmate) quiz you or ask you questions from the study guide or practice test
5. Make flash cards with vocabulary words or questions, with the definition or answer on the back so you can quiz yourself. (Quizlet is an online flashcard program)
6. Be sure to ask questions IN CLASS about information that you are not sure about before the test.
