"Why voter suppression continues and how the pandemic has made it worse"

One-Pager

In this activity, you will take the most important concepts that you have learned about a specific topic (in this case, what you learned about voter suppression from the PBS NewsHour Podcast, "America Interrupted") and put the information onto a single piece of paper. You should combine images and information and make your one-pager standout as well as explain. Your one-pager should mix language and imagery. For example, you could emphasize certain words by making them larger or offset them, you could draw pictures, and/or include symbols.

Step 1: Listen to this podcast, *PBS NewsHour: America, Interrupted, Why voter suppression continues and how the pandemic has made it worse.*

Step 2: Examine the notes that you took as you listened to the podcast on Student Handout #1.

Step 3: Create your one-pager on 8.5x 11 paper

- Include these required elements in your one-pagers. You may include other relevant elements too!
 - Quotations from the podcast
 - Key themes from the podcast
 - Important people from the podcast
 - o Important dates from the podcast
 - Connections to other historical periods (or to right now)

Step 4: Take a picture of your one-pager and submit it or hand it in in-person.

Rubric- 1/3 each. (Check the boxes to make sure you've done them.)

- □ Podcast Analysis—it's evident that you listened to the podcast and integrated what you have learned from it into your one-pager. You've included quotes and details from the podcast.
- ☐ Required Elements—You've included all of these.
- ☐ Thoroughness, neatness, and/or creativity—Your one-pager is thorough, neat, and creative.
