Meeting called to order 7:34pm

Agenda was reviewed and a motion to approve the agenda as submitted was made by Monroeville Marlins Swim Team, Chuck Kaminski. Motion seconded by Woodland Hills Aquatic Team, coach Walt.

Minutes from Spring HOD meeting were accepted after individual member review. Motion to adopt Killer Whales Swimming, Josh Mariana. Second by Elizabeth Prager, Cavalier Swimming.

General Chair Todd Sterlitz gave a state of the LSC including the recent BoD Retreat and review of the Strategic Plan of the LSC. Todd informed the delegates of the HoD of recent LSC sponsored camps, upcoming competition schedule, as well as the successes of athletes at zone meets, sectional meets, national meets. A Presidents roundtable meeting was hosted with the president of all member teams immediately prior to the HoD meeting. The major themes discussed were relayed to all of the stakeholders. A focus on proper meet management techniques and education for clubs will be developed and disseminated.

Presentation of the Budget and Finance Committee presentation

A presentation of the 2026 proposed budget and concerns to be addressed by the new finance committee was described. Finance Chair Scott Wilshire explained the budget, as well as the categories comprising the financial picture of the LSC. The assets, cost of goods sold (all expenditures related to athletes), and expenses of the entity were laid out and questions were answered to the satisfaction of all stakeholders. A motion to accept and approve the budget was made by Blair Regional Y, Tom Grassadonia and seconded by JCC Sailfish, Dave Watterson.

Old Business

A note was made that records of the LSC should be reviewed for accuracy. Old records which predate the current SWIMS system are not reflected on the current list.

New Business

A presentation was made regarding the three counties located in the state of Ohio which heretofore belonged to the Allegheny Mountain Swimming LSC. It was noted that Allegheny Mountain Swimming has no presence in these counties. With the merger of Lake Erie Swimming and Ohio Swimming into a single entity, there was a discussion regarding the desire and appropriateness of ceding the three Ohio Counties back to the new larger Ohio Swimming LSC. After discussion, a vote of the membership brought a unanimous decision to cede the mentioned counties to Ohio Swimming. Motion by Donna Beyerl, second by Scott Wilshire. Vote of the stakeholders Unanimous.

Meeting was adjourned on motion of Donna Beyerl, second by Ryan, Norwin Aqua Club coach.
