Once you land at Juan Manuel Galvez (RTB), Roatan's Int'l Airport, you will go through <u>customs and immigration</u> in the same big room that your luggage gets to delivered to. Then you exit and there is one big room with a couple of stores, the check in counters and a couple of rental car kiosks. That's it. It's a very small airport. You can find taxis ready to take you to

our cabin right outside the doors for about \$60 one way, but we recommend renting a car.

We've rented from Avis, Sixt, and Oscar Car Rentals. Sixt has 4 wheel drive trucks for around

\$50/day after taxes as of late 2024. They should be reserved online well before your trip. Both

have offices at the airport. Oscar Car Rentals is locally owned and provides the fastest, least

stressful experience for about the same or less than the well-known rental agencies.

Driving to the Cabin

From the airport, you will turn right or go east. There is only one main road called the Carretera

Principal. You will take this road all the way to just past Oak Ridge before turning right into

Diamond Rock Road. On your way you will drive through French Harbor where there are

several stores and our favorite grocery store, Eldon's.

So after a grocery stop, get back on Carretera Principal going east and when you see the Oak

Ridge sign about 20 minutes later, stay to your left, don't go straight.



You'll go around a right curve and then before it curves sharply to the left, you turn right onto Diamond Ridge road.



You'll go around a few curves, and after you see the abandoned mini mall on the right, and a new development called Aroha on the left, Punta Blanca Road will be on the left just after.



Turn there and go down the hill until you come to the fork in the road with all the cabin signs. You'll see ours at the top directing you to the left (though if you stay on that loop you could actually go right as well as long as you don't go down the hill to the right). Go about 400 meters until you reach a fence that says Añoranza, right before the road curves sharply to the right.

Turn left down our steep driveway and we're the only home at the end of the drive. Pull onto the concrete pad under the deck if you want!
