

## **David Senter**

### **Summery:**

Birth – Circa between 1747/48 - Dunstable, Middlesex County, Massachusetts (year based on his purchase of land in 1769, needed to be at least 21 y.o., age of majority)

Circa May 2, 1769 – July 3, 1777 - “of Moultonborough” N.H.

Circa Jan 4, 1781 – Jan 20, 1781 – “of New Hampton” N.H.

Circa Sep 17, 1781 – Feb 27, 1793 – “of Plymouth” N.H. \*

Circa Apr 17, 1794 – Nov 9, 1819 - “of Danville” VT

Death - Nov 9, 1819 - Danville, Caledonia County, Vermont

### **Evidence:**

**1769, May 2 – “of Moultonborough”** purchased 250 acres from Johnathan Moulton Esq - Moultonborough, Strafford County (now Carroll County), New Hampshire.

**1777, July 3 - “of Moultonborough”** sold 60 acres of land in Moultonborough to Enoch Cates. Moultonborough, Strafford County, N. H.

**1781, Jan 4 – “of New Hampton”** sold 200 acres of land in Moultonborough to Ezekiel Morse. New Hampton, Strafford County, N.H. (David and “Susa” signed document)

**1781, Jan 20 – “of New Hampton”** purchased many acres in Plymouth from Thomas Lucas. New Hampton, Strafford County, N.H.

**1781, Sep 17 – “of Plymouth”** purchased 14 acres in Plymouth from Samuel M. Plymouth, Grafton County, N.H.

**1783, Dec 12 – David Senter is one of 92 males enumerated in Plymouth.**

**1793, Feb 27 – “of Plymouth”** sold 10 acres in Plymouth to James Blodgett.

### **Most likely left for Walden’s Gore/Danville that Spring**

**1794, Apr 17 – “of Danville formerly Walden Gore”** Orange County, purchased 160 acres in Danville from James Crofs. Danville, Caledonia County, Vermont

**\*1797, Oct 3** – A pew was sold in the Plymouth, NH Meeting House. At this time, the name David Senter was struck off at Vendue (probably left it unpaid). The pew was adjoining the ministerial Pew on the lower floor. This indicates he had high standing in the community being so close to the minister.

**1800, Aug 4** – Federal Census – Danville, Caledonia County, VT

**1810 – Federal Census** – Danville, Caledonia County, VT (His name misspelled David Center).

1819, Nov 9 – Death in Danville, Caledonia County, Vermont

## **Lucretia Senter**

### **Summary** (assuming David Senter is her father):

Birth – Feb 23, 1779 – Most likely either Moultonborough or New Hampton, possibly Center Harbor, New Hampshire. (*based on fathers land records*)

Circa Sep 17, 1781 – Feb 27, 1793 – Plymouth New Hampshire (*fathers land records*)

Circa Apr 17, 1794 – Nov 3, 1799 - Danville Vermont (*fathers land records*)

Nov 3, 1799 - 1821, Feb – Danville/ Clarendon Vermont (Marriage, Census of Husband)

Feb 4, 1821 – Dec 7, 1871 - Tioga County, Pennsylvania (Birth of children, Census)

Death - Dec 7, 1871 - Westfield, Tioga County, Pennsylvania

**1799, Nov 3 – Marriage to William Dyer Weeks (Weekes, Wicks), Danville, Caledonia County, Vermont**

1800 – Birth of daughter Elizabeth Senter Weeks (Ladd), Vermont

1801 – Birth of daughter Susannah Weeks, Vermont

1804, Sep 10 – Birth of daughter Emeline Weeks (Hunter), Rutland County, Vermont

1806 – Birth of son Dyer Weeks, Vermont

1808 – Birth of son Philander J Weeks, New York

**1810 – Federal Census** – Clarendon, Rutland County, Vermont (Implied, husband William Weeks)

1811, Jun 11 – Birth of daughter Lucinda Weeks (Cosper), Rutland County, Vermont

1813 – Birth of daughter Lucia A. Weeks (Cole), near Burlington, Vermont

1816 – Birth of daughter Sally Weeks, Tioga County, Pennsylvania (doubtful location)

1819 – Birth of son Lewis C Weeks, Vermont

**1820 Federal Census** – Clarendon, Rutland County, Vermont (Implied, husband William Weeks)

1821, Feb 4 – Birth of son Noah Senter Weeks, Tioga County, Pennsylvania

**1830 Federal Census** – Westfield, Tioga County, Pennsylvania (Implied, husband William Weeks)

**1840 Federal Census** – Westfield, Tioga County, Pennsylvania (Implied, husband William Weeks)

**1844, Dec 11** – William Weeks property briefly mentioned in local newspaper (as a boundary).

1850, Mar 27 – Death of husband William Weeks, Westfield, Tioga County, Pennsylvania

**1850, Nov 5 – Federal Census** – Lucretia listed living with daughter Elizabeth Senter Ladd and S.I.L. William Ladd III, Westfield, Tioga County, Pennsylvania. Note: Her birth location is given as “N.H.”

**1860, Aug 25 – Federal Census** – Lucretia listed living with daughter Elizabeth Senter Ladd and S.I.L. William Ladd III, Westfield, Tioga County, Pennsylvania. Note: Her birth location is given as “N.H.”

**1870, Aug 3 – Federal Census** – Lucretia listed living with daughter Elizabeth Senter Ladd and S.I.L. William Ladd III, Westfield, Tioga County, Pennsylvania. Note: Her birth location is given as “N.H.” Also, she is listed as a male, her name is spelled “Leicires” and age is 91

1870, Dec – Death of daughter Susannah Weeks, Tioga County, Pennsylvania

**1871, Dec 7** – Death of Lucretia Weeks (Senter), Westfield, Tioga County, Pennsylvania.
