13.	How can we cultivate a household where sound theology is not only taught but lived and modeled in every area of life?
14.	What does it mean to 'think God's thoughts after Him' in the context of marriage and fatherhood?
15.	How can we guard our homes from theological drift and keep Christ at the center of our family life?
