President opens the conversation and discusses needing help. Each person can sign up to take on one event.

Kristin Erdheim would like to mentor and help rebuild the PTA.' She wants to see teachers join the PTA. Three people are interested in a position. One is interested in shared position for secretary. Another is interest in program coordinator. The third person is interested in treasurer. Kristin Erdheim talked about helping someone during the year and co-sharing the treasurer. A parent on zoom is interested in program coordinator.

There was a discussion amongst board member that there was interest in all these events but then people disappeared.

They would like to see more movie nights since the kids love these types of events.

A parent brought up collaborating with Bar-T to pay them to help with events and then in return have more equipment to use to make the events more exciting.

Literacy night and math night were the two events to have the staff do these events. They are looking to get more teacher involvement outside of their contractual amount. They need at least two events to sign up for. There are 3 teachers that come to many events.

Board discussed not doing as many events as last year or adding any new events.

School store is very popular and usually is done Tuesday morning 8:30a.m. to 9:00a.m.

The person who does the books and beyond is still going to do it next year.

Monthly meeting snacks for staff/staff appreciation- discuss giving back to staff.

Restaurant nights- There was someone who did this last year, but she won't be doing this again for the next school year. We made \$1,100 this year. Restaurants give 10% or 15%. PTA tries to make sure restaurant night is not the same night as the other schools in the area.

Kristin Mitas closes out discussing the interest in the positions and signing up for the positions. The bylaws are one-year terms. You must be a member of the PTA and can be a teacher to be on the board.

Someone on zoom asked what should be prioritized when trying to rebuild the PTA. A response was given that we only need to have four meetings during the year and that they need another group of people who will lead events.

PTA board members discussed having a summer meeting. During this summer meeting one person can sign up for each event to take on and they can show where the PTA closet is.
