Cautions and Contraindications to Morpheus8 Body

- Surgery in the direct treatment area within the last 12 months
- Implants in the treatment area (vaginal mesh or bladder sling for example)
- Cardiac pacemaker or defibrillator (absolute contraindications)
- History of oral or genital herpes, cold sores, or fever blisters (we need to treat to prevent outbreak)
- Current skin cancer or history of skin cancer (we cannot treat over any abnormal or concerning moles or skin lesions)
- Poorly controlled chronic illnesses (diabetes, hypertension, heart disease, or autoimmune disease – these can impair your healing)
- History of epidermal, dermal, collagen, or microvascular problems (can impair your healing)
- Active electrical implant in any region of the body that cannot be turned off or disabled during treatment
- Pregnancy (absolute contraindication)
- Nursing, breastfeeding (can be done, but has not been studied for safety)
- Diseases of the immune system (HIV, AIDS, leukemia, etc – can impair your healing)
- Medications that suppress the immune system (can impair your healing)
- Bleeding disorders (increases excessive bleeding with microneedling)
- History of keloids or abnormal wound healing (you likely will have problems healing from this)
- Tattoo in the treatment area (we cannot treat over a tattoo)
- Any active condition in the treatment area (open wounds, infections, abrasions, lesions, psoriasis, eczema, or other rashes)
- History of Accutane in the past 6 months
- Light, laser, radiofrequency or other devices in the treatment area within the past 3 weeks
- Ablative fractional laser resurfacing within the past 12 weeks
- Use of NSAIDs, antiinflammatories, or aspirin within 1 week before each treatment session (increases the risk of bleeding)
- Excessively tanned skin in the treatment area from sun, tanning beds, or tanning creams (increases risk of burning or pigmentation problems)
