Mandatory Fees:

Annual Membership Fee:

Access to 2 support hours/month, events, New Sun Rising resource guides, Grant and Award Opportunities, newsletter, and more. All fiscal sponsorship agreements expire December 31st and renewals occur each January (annually). Projects that are in good standing will sign a new annual agreement and process payment for the new year to renew their membership.

Comprehensive Membership:

\$525 annually or \$55/month.

Comprehensive projects are covered under New Sun Rising's general liability insurance policy unless otherwise arranged.

The project must participate in a yearly Impact Report.

Pre-Approved Membership:

\$125 annually. Projects who are approved in July or later are \$75 for the remainder of that year.

Pre-approved projects MUST carry their own general liability insurance and add New Sun Rising as additionally insured (commonly called COI)

The project must participate in a yearly Impact Report.

Administrative Cost:

Starts at 10% for MOST grants and ALL donations. Government grants and more complex grant applications/reporting may require an increased fee.

Additional Insurance Fees:

Projects that are high risk may need additional insurance and any expenses incurred as a result will become the project's responsibility.
