# Ultrasound gave her clarity!

When she first came through our doors, this 17-year-old client was planning on an abortion. She felt the weight of her circumstances and feared she wouldn't have her family's support. But as we sat together and gently explored her options, something began to shift.

She admitted that deep down, she had always wanted to be a mom. For the first time, she allowed herself to imagine the "what ifs" — what if her mom did support her, what if things really could work out, what if this timing, though unexpected, could still be beautiful?

Tears filled her eyes as she began to see a new possibility. By the end of the appointment, her heart had softened, and she was no longer set on abortion.




Instead, she left with hope and a growing desire to keep her baby. Her boyfriend, though scared, stood beside her, ready to support her choice.

People may be at different points of their journey in understanding that, but the name LIV is meant to cal people unto their original design; to live the life they were made for.
