Noun Phrase	A phrase whose headword is a noun
Verb	a word that denotes present and past tense; it has both an -s form and an -ing form
Sentence (definition)	Subject + predicate
Determiner (article)	The avid skier looked forward to his trip to Colorado.
Demonstrative Pronouns	<u>This</u> old house needs a lot of work.
Proper Nouns (definition)	Specific names of people and places
Noun	A word that can be made plural or possessive; it occupies the headword position in the noun phrase; it is usually signaled by a determiner
Suffixes	Word endings
Verb phrase (example)	The students <u>wrote furiously</u> on the exam.

Determiner (possessive pronoun)	Their dog was evil.
Determiner (demonstrative pronoun)-examples	this, that, those, these
Proper Noun (possessive)	<u>George's</u> boat is neat.
Determiner (definition)	noun signaler
Proper Nouns (examples)	Katherine, National Cathedral, Old Town Alexandria
Sentence (example)	Make sure you are getting enough sleep!
