Established in 1963, Moses Brown's RISE camp offers arts, academics, science, sports, adventure, and fun to children ages 3-14. There are three divisions- Early RISers (ages 3 to 4), Lower Camp (ages 5-7), and Upper Camp (ages 8-14) that are all located on MB's Providence campus. As part of Moses Brown, we affirm the Quaker belief that there is an Inner Light in each person that is worthy of dignity and respect. We consider simplicity, integrity, group wisdom, and respect for differences to be paramount in helping campers of all faiths and backgrounds discover their identity and mission in the world. Purpose/Objective:

RISE camp counselors provide supervision to campers ages 5-14 in daily camp activities.

Major Responsibilities:

- Approximately 37.5 hours per week (daily 8:15 am-3:30 pm), with an end time of 4:15 on Wednesdays to allow for an all staff meeting.
- Reports to the Director of Upper or Lower RISE (depending on placement)
- Supervise campers between the ages of 5-14
- Plan and execute activities for camp group
- Work in collaboration with other RISE counselors and directors.
- All other duties as assigned

Skills, Knowledge, Competencies:

- Understanding of best practices in elementary education and the developmental needs of students aged 3-11 years old necessary; ability to supervise staff; willingness to communicate clearly with staff and parents essential
- This position is considered a staff position.
- CPR certification preferred
- Physical demands: this position is required to sit on the floor with children, lift up to 50 lbs
- Enjoy working with children
- Be creative and comfortable problem solvers
- Exhibit strong leadership skills as well as being organized and responsible.



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- Counselors with special interests or talents will be given responsibilities that play to these unique strengths.
- Working directly with their camp division director, counselors must be able work in a team environment and collaborate with others.
