- Ibraheem Iqbal - Diagnosed with keratoconus and rod-cone dystrophy, registered blind at age 13. Ibraheem is a qualified personal trainer and former Paralympic athlete-in-training. He is a disability rights ambassador and mentor for visually-impaired people and their families.
