Statement of History

Barney, Lester and Arden Oldfield attended Johnson County Schools namely Long Branch and Elk Creek Schools.

Col. Oldfield and his brothers were beneficiaries of educational opportunities in Johnson County Schools and Barney has established, in memory of his brothers, a scholarship to make it possible for a graduate of a Johnson County High School to have an opportunity to receive financial assistance during the freshman year at the University of Nebraska - Lincoln.

Lester Oldfield was inducted into the Lincoln High School Sports Hall of Fame for two years as Nebraska's 100 Yard Backstroke State Champion. At the University of Nebraska-Lincoln, he had two unbeaten seasons in which he had 63 starts and 63 first place finishes. He was the Big Six 100 Yard Backstroke Champion. He served as an Army Air Force pilot in World War II.

Arden made his career in aeronautical construction and boat building in California.
