Three Things About Hell:

Hell is a literal, large, and lasting place. It is full of everlasting suffering, enduring sorrow and eternal separation from God. What are your beliefs about hell? Do they align with Scripture? How might your beliefs be changed by God's Word? How might knowing the truth about hell create more urgency in you to share the message of Christ with others? What specific person or people in your life might need to hear it?

1. Turn from your sin. Sin separates us from God, but God's grace unites us to Him again. God doesn't send people to hell; their sin does. What are some ways that you need to turn from your sin? What support and accountability do you need?

2. Trust in your Savior. What are you trusting your Savior to do? Is this trust easy or difficult for you? Why? Have you also made Him your Lord?
