I teach Business Law and Trial Practice. I also work with Logan Stegner, Ryan White, and other teachers and coaches to run our after-school and summer weight training programs, and work with Chris Pierson, Judge Brandon Mack, and others to coach the school's YMCA Mock Trial Team.

Before finding my way to teaching, I worked as a lawyer for 35 years, primarily doing business litigation and employment law and litigation. Over the years, I probably handled every type of workplace lawsuit that you can imagine.

In my free time, I lifted weights, competed in powerlifting contests, and won five National Championships in the bench press in drug-free powerlifting contests. This led me to write a book about drug-free strength training. I self-published the book in 1996, and it became a best-seller in the field. It was so popular that I started a side business selling books and courses about strength training and related topics. Today, almost 30 years later, I'm still writing about these topics, and still running my on-line business.

My wife and I moved to Port Townsend in 2019. After moving here, I began doing workouts at the beach at Fort Worden State Park, where I carried driftwood logs up and down the beach. I did this so much that other beach-goers began calling me "Log Man."

After I started working with students in the high school weight room, I began training there exclusively. After several months in the weight room, I entered and won several AAU Weightlifting championships, including the Age 65 Masters Division of the AAU World Championships in 2023. I did this because I wanted to show students that we have a pretty good weight room here – and if you use it the right way, you'll surprise yourself with what you accomplish.

My goal in teaching and coaching is to help students achieve unusual success in all of their academic courses, and in any sports, clubs or other activities they choose to pursue – and to have lots of fun doing it.
