Lessons can be taught over multiple days/weeks/months. Lessons are used during "Tech Tuesdays" or "Fun Friday" ELA station time. Each lesson starts with a review of

how to get to Jungle Junior website and the lesson/letter they should be starting with. [edclub \(typingclub.com\)](http://edclub.typingclub.com)

1. Start with lesson number 1 on the website "Start here". Go through interactive video. Have students follow along on their ipads (or chromebooks/computers). **K-1.IC.6**
2. Review correct posture/positioning for keyboarding-Feet on the floor, sitting up straight
3. Repeat this with the next lesson. **K-1.NSD.1**
4. For students that are able to pick up the typing more quickly, they can work at their own pace. The interactive videos explain how to use the keyboard and what specific letter they are working on typing
5. Students work at their tables in the correct keyboarding position. Staff supports students as needed

- Students will need to know how to navigate safari in order to find Jungle Junior website. They will need to have prior knowledge of what a keyboard is and it's purpose.
