5 mins	Introduction:	Provided above
	Introduce the topic - Revision of Term 3 signs.  Q & A with our presenters.	
	Today for our last lesson this term, we will watch as our presenters are interviewed with 'voice over' questions.  However this time we will have 'no voice over' for the responses (to start), so you must watch to recognise their answer signs. We've kept it simple to give you practice at watching and recognising signs that you have been taught.  Have a try! I'm sure that you will understand most, if not all, that the presenters are signing. It's important to develop this skill. Have a go!

10 mins	Explicit Teaching: Watch the video	Lesson 30 video
	Use teacher discretion to decide if the class needs to watch any part of the video a second time.	
	<b>Taught this lesson:</b> The focus for this lesson is to revise previously taught signs, as you watch to understand the presenters' responses to questions.	
5 mins	Explanation of Activity:	Ougstions Chast
	Naomie answers Elvin's questions about nature walks, restaurant visits, modern technology and school.	Questions Sheet Q and A reference sheets to check the answers! (find below)
	<ul> <li>Responses to the Questions:</li> <li>Teacher reminds the students of the questions (see Question sheet)</li> </ul>	

	<ul> <li>In small groups the students discuss which answers they could understand from Elvin's questioning.</li> <li>The small group of students will confer with each other to clarify the meaning of signs they saw on the video, (Recognition of signs taught) and translating those signs into English.</li> <li>The students return to the class group to share what they believe was said, from notes they took.</li> <li>The teacher and whole class compare their ideas, and check the answers on the sheet provided.</li> </ul>	
15 mins	Activity:	
	<ul> <li>Small group chat to discuss and comprehend the answers to the questions from Elvin.</li> <li>Share with the class and check the answers.</li> </ul>	
5 mins	Reflection with Students: (Select from the following options)	
	<ul> <li>When watching the video, how much of the answers could you understand?</li> <li>Did you quickly recognise some signs that you had been taught?</li> <li>Which signs did you forget?</li> <li>Could you see the Auslan structure differences that we learnt about in Lesson 24?</li> </ul>
