

Since there is a Tinker Talent Academy, I thought there should be other talent academies as well! Here is my idea on what those will be like and what subjects will be taught in them.

Nature Talents

Animal Academy

Location-In a tree in the forest; animals are allowed on school grounds at all times

Class sample:

- Animals & Food-This course touches on how to find out what a certain animal's favorite and least favorite foods are
- Animal Choreography-This course teaches how to choreograph an animal dance routine. It ends in a performance.
- Animal Lullabies-How to play the perfect lullaby for a hibernating animal using a variety of instruments
- Butterfly Gathering-Butterflies are possibly the most difficult animal to work with. Hopefully this course will help you outsmart them!
- Silkworm Thread-How to collect thread from silkworms without hurting them

Air Academy (Fast-Flying)

Location-Atop a mountain on a high, windy peak

Class sample:

- Air Art-Yes, artwork can be created with wind and clouds, even though it's always animated in some way
- Creating Breezes-Learn how to create and control wind of various speeds
- Fast flying-Learn how to increase your speed and learn extreme flying tricks. Multiple flight classes are offered at this school. Assignments may include racing dragonflies
- Messaging-Learn how to memorize important messages and different methods of having them delivered to the right person
- Tornadoes-This course does *not* teach the art of making destructive tornadoes; small tornadoes can be great for collecting and releasing things like pollen

Garden Academy

Location-In a garden surrounded by exotic flowers; there is also an indoor greenhouse

Class sample:

- Flower Painting-How to give flowers their correct color
- Fruit Cultivation-The planting and painting of fruit
- Mushroom Cultivation-The art of growing and opening up mushrooms
- Seed Sorting-How to distinguish between different seeds and properly sort them
- Veggie Cultivation-The growing and polishing of veggies

Light Academy

Location-On a high peak near a gorgeous night sky; the school even has an observatory! The building has a glass ceiling and many glass walls which are perfect for stargazing

- Astronomy-Learn about the stars and constellations
- Illumination-Light up flowers, fireflies, and lamps and increase your glow
- Fairy Fireworks-Create fireworks with the help of light and flower pigments
- Light bending-How to move light to open up sunflowers, melt snow, or anything else it may be used for
- Rainbow Making-How to combine light and mist to create rainbows

Water Academy

Location-Floating on a peaceful pond next to a flowing waterfall

- Cobweb Decorating-Learn to put dewdrops on cobwebs
- Fountains and Waterfalls-Learn how to create water fountains
- Water Art-Create artwork such as water/ice sculptures, decorative fountains, and more! Water art is kind of animated too
- Water Boiling/Freezing-Change the temperature of water
- Working with Fish-Learn their language and how to communicate with them

Weather Academy

Location-It takes place in an area where the weather is always chaotic. There could be a thunderstorm one minute, a blizzard the next, and sunshine after that

- Calm Weather-How do you make a chaotic storm calm? How do you clear away the clouds to make the sun shine?
- Fire Magic-Cultivating and controlling fire is one of the more difficult and dangerous types of magic
- Thunderstorms-It is quite complicated magic because it combines water magic with lightning and thunder

- Weather Predicting-Learn how to accurately predict the weather for the next hour or day
- Wind Magic-It is very similar to the breeze class in Air Academy

Winter Academy

Location-In the Arctic atop a glacier

- Frost-Work on frosting objects; frost is like a blanket that tucks the warm air in and keeps out the cold
- Frost Art-Similar to the Frost class only it teaches how to create art out of frost
- Ice-Learn how to magically carve things out of ice and use it for various purposes
- Snowflakes-No two are alike; how are they carefully crafted? How do you use the wind to sweep the snowflakes into pouches?
- Winter Animals-Which animals hibernate in the winter and which ones are awake? This course also teaches fairies how to communicate with the later

Safeguard Talents

Safeguard Academy

Location-In a dense, mystical forest

Class sample:

- Camouflage-How to hide from predators by blending in with nature
- Combat-This physical education-based course teaches one how to fight a foe using magic and physical fighting techniques
- Far Listening-Increase your sense of hearing and learn how to spot a predator that may be coming
- Far Seeing-How do you see things that other fairies or humans might not be able to see? This course teaches how to see things through glass and to use keen eyesight to spot predators

Craftmanship Talents

School of the Arts for Fairies

Location-In the middle of a vibrant garden some of the artsy students like to work on

Class sample:

- Acting-A variety of popular plays and stories amongst the world of fairies are practiced. A play is done by this class (with some singing and dancing thrown in) at the end of the term
- Gem Sorting-Learn how to sort gems used for various artistic purposes such as tailoring and handicrafts
- Orchestra-Play an instrument? Work on playing songs popular amongst fairies around the world. The orchestra performs in concerts throughout the year. There is also a choir class
- Sewing-Create a variety of fairy-sized garments. The course ends with a fashion show
- Visual Art-Learn how to draw and paint objects or scenes of choice using fairy-dusted tools. Students will participate in an art show at the end of each term

Tinker Academy

Location-In a metallic building in a distant island

This is a school that focuses on fixing and creating inventions. It was built in the late 1800s in Britain during the dawn of the Industrial Revolution when more and more fairies became interested in inventing. When Tinkerbell went there in the very end of the 1800s, it was ahead of Pixie Hollow in terms of tinkering in that metal and steam were frequently used. After Tink returned to Pixie Hollow, she got her fellow tinkers interested in the metal found in the wilderness leading to metal being more and more frequently used in pots and pans.

Culinary Talents

Culinary Academy for Fairies

Location-The school is by a fruit orchard and a veggie garden. Fun fact; all the meals are cooked by the students!

Class sample:

- Baking-Make sweet muffins, cakes, breads and more! Fire tending is touched upon in this class
- Cooking-Make a variety of savory dishes with a stovetop in this course!
- Kitchen-This course teaches other jobs that can be done in the kitchen not involving food preparation. They include dishwashing, food storage and stove to plate transfer
- Tea Making-Learn how to brew a wide variety of teas. This course also teaches how to find the tea leaves

Service Talents

Academy for Healers

Location-Near a garden full of ingredients for remedies

There are two areas of study; healing and nursing. Healing focuses on potions and medicines. Nursing focuses on mending physical injuries like scrapes, cuts and broken bones.

Cleaning Academy for Fairies

Location-In a slightly cluttered area of a forest; cleaning the school is part of class work

- Dusting-Which size duster will be the best used for dusting a certain object? How do you get all the dust out without sneezing?
- Laundry-Learn how to hand wash delicate clothing and properly fold them
- Polishing-Learn how to give a shine to various objects such as entryways and silverware
- Window Washing-How to wash window glass until it's so clear it's as if the window is completely open
- Wing Washing-Fairy wings are very delicate and difficult to wash. But wing-washers are necessary because fairies can't wash their own wings. This is also a useful skill for any fairy if they want to wash a friend's wing
