•**Science** must include 3 credits of Earth and Space Science, 3 credits of biology and 3 credits of chemistry OR physics (students need 9 credits of science to graduate).

••**General Physical Education** 1 credit, can be taken at any grade level and required for graduation.

•••**Economics or AP Macroeconomics or AP Microeconomics** can be taken during 11th or 12th grade and required for graduation.

••••**Personal Finance & Money Management** can be taken during 11th or 12th grade and required for graduation.

-**Embedded Health** is offered each year for .25 credit for a total of 1 health credit required for graduation.

-**Fine Arts Requirement:** All students must earn **two credits** in Fine Arts (any art, music, theater or certain design courses) See courses at a glance for specific courses that meet this requirement.

-**World Language** courses are not required to graduate, however most four-year colleges like to see at least two years of the same world language.

-**You must register for 18 credits each year;** if you plan on taking 916/PSEO/Senior Study etc. your schedule will be changed later. Students need **66** out of a possible 72 credits to graduate
