



**Announcement of Nathom Provincial Police Station**  
**story Anti-Bribery Policy**  
**and not to accept gifts, gifts or any other benefits. (No Gift Policy) from the**  
**performance of duties.**  
**Fiscal Year 2025**

According to the Constitutional Act on Prevention and Suppression of Corruption, B.E. 2561 (2018), Section 128 Paragraph 1 stipulates that any government official is prohibited from receiving property or any other benefits that may be calculated as income from anyone. In addition to property or legitimate benefits under the law. Rules or regulations issued by virtue of the authority under the provisions of the law, except for the receipt of property or any other benefits by virtue of the rules and amounts set by the Board of Directors. and the Code of Ethics for Police Officers B.E. 2564 (2021), Clause 2(2) Honesty and Integrity Perform legal duties. Regulation of the Royal Thai Police Agency with transparency Do not express behavior that implies exploitation, wrongdoing, and responsibility for human rights duties. Ready to be audited and held accountable. Have a good conscience, consider society, and 2(4) Think about the common good rather than personal interests. Have a public spirit, cooperate, cooperate and sacrifice in doing good for the common good and creating benefits for the society, in conjunction with the National Reform Plan on Prevention and Suppression of Corruption and Misconduct (Revised Version). Determine the major reform activities. 4 Develop the Thai bureaucracy to be transparent and profit-free. 1 Article 1.1 All government agencies shall declare as agencies where all government officials do not accept gifts and gifts of any kind from the performance of their duties. (No Gift Policy)

Therefore, in order to prevent conflicts between personal interests and public interests (Conflict of Interest) Therefore, the guidelines for anti-bribery (Anti-Bribery Policy)

and not accepting gifts, gifts or any other benefits (No Gift Policy) From the performance of their duties, the details are as follows:

article 1 This Announcement

“commander” means a person who has the authority and duty to direct, supervise, monitor and inspect police officers under his or her jurisdiction (can be adjusted according to the wording of the police)

"Bribe" means any property or other benefit given to a person to incentivize him or her to act or not to do any act in office. Whether it is right or wrong with duty.

“Duty” It means that it is an act or performance of duties of a government official. In a position appointed or assigned to perform any of the duties or to act in place of the public in any of the duties both general and specific as a police officer prescribed by law. Authority and duties or acts in accordance with the authority and duties specified by law to have the authority and duties of the police.

“Gifts, gifts, or any other benefits that affect the performance of duties.” means money, property, services or any other benefits of value and provided including tips received by a government official in addition to salary. Income, government benefits in normal cases and affect decision-making. approval Permission or any other way to perform their duties in a manner that is conducive to corruption to the giver of the gift either in the past or at the time of receiving or in the future.

Clause 2 Police officers at all levels shall behave. as follows

1Do not ask for guidance, do not give or do not accept bribes, gifts, gifts or any other benefits from the performance of duties.

2Do not consent or knowingly allow family members to give or accept bribes, gifts, gifts or any other benefits to those who are involved in the performance of their duties.

3. The performance of duties must be based on law enforcement with fairness, the interests and image of the police as the priority. The employee must not commit any act that is a conflict between personal interests and public interests, such as receiving gifts or any other benefits that affect the performance of duties., The use of

government resources for personal gain., Disclosure of inside information  
Crowding out official time for special work, etc.

4. Reduce the giving or receipt of property or any other benefits in accordance with the rules and amounts specified by the NCPO Office by using the method of expression by signing greeting cards, greeting books, condolence cards, or using social media instead of giving things.

5. Refused I can't stand it. Not indifferent. for the behavior of accepting bribes, gifts, gifts or any other benefits from the performance of their duties./The station chief will know as soon as possible.

article 3 The supervisor shall have the authority and duty to supervise, monitor and inspect the police officers under his or her command to act in accordance with this Notification. In case of any violation of this Notice, report to the Superintendent./The station chief will know as soon as possible.

article 4 Anyone who finds any violation of this Notice. Complaints/whistleblowers can be made directly to the Superintendent of Nathom Provincial Police Station. The information of the complainant/whistleblower will be concealed and kept strictly confidential.

article 5 In case of receiving complaints/clues Personnel affiliated with the offense committed the offense at the police station will conduct a fact-check. And if an offense is found, the perpetrator will be punished according to the law. Strictly follow the relevant rules and regulations and continue to submit matters according to the hierarchy of command.
