Coffee and Donut Sundays (Once a Month)

Usually supported by two people and volunteers sign up for dates they can support. You will supply donuts or other goodies for folks attending. Prepare the space for the event and set out supplies (usually done Sat. late afternoon). Sunday morning, make coffee, set out the food, assure things go well during the event, clean up as the event winds down.

Time Commitment: this event is the first Sunday of the month, about 1 hour total prep, about an 1 hour for the event, and some cleanup time

Church Greeters

Welcome people walking into church, answer any questions. If there is a special event after mass be sure and remind them. Goal is to make everyone feel welcomed and a part of our parish “family”.

Time Commitment: Variable - volunteers will sign up for Sundays they can be a greeter. Arrive at least 15 minutes before mass to greet folks.

Volunteer Coordinator

This person will coordinate volunteers and assure we have volunteers for key events like Coffee and Donut Sunday, special events, the twice annual big church cleaning project etc.

Time Commitment: Variable typically no more than 2 hours a week

Parish Office Volunteer Assistant

Assist the parish office with administrative tasks such as answering phones, greeting visitors, making copies, filing, assisting with the bulletin production, and other administrative tasks as needed.

Time Commitment: variable based on volunteers availability.

Liturgical Environment and/or Sacristans

Help decorate the Church for weekly Masses and liturgical feast days. Or volunteer for a more specific role as a sacristan. The sacristan will prepare the church for mass, unlock the church, turn on all lights, get the audio set up, prepare all the vessels, vestments, candles, and liturgical items used at Mass, and clean up and put things away after Mass.

Time Commitment: 1-2 hours a week – rotates with multiple volunteers. The role of sacristan will require some training.

Altar Linens

Order, pick up, assure payments are scheduled, and arrange flowers for the altar and other areas of the church as needed. Assure ongoing arrangements are maintained and clean up and properly store all flower vases, etc.

Time Commitment: Weekly – with more volunteers, times will rotate.

Likely activities include, assisting with basic maintenance, checking on the status and cleanliness of the parish hall after events, assisting with church, rectory and parish hall maintenance and communications.
