Attendance Policy:

Meeting Attendance: While meetings listed on this highlight list are mandatory, attendance is expected at all weekly meetings.

Conference Attendance: Delegates are expected to attend each conference during the program year. Conferences provide valuable program information, education, and the chance for fellowship with your fellow delegates. In particular, however:

- For T&EII (Jan): Partial attendance is not permitted except in extraordinary circumstances. Regular season sport events, meets, regular season academic club meets, finals, school projects, etc, are not extraordinary circumstances. You are expected to travel to the conference with the delegation, attend the entire conference, and travel home again with the delegation.
- For ML/C ("Sac Conference," Feb): Partial attendance is not permitted.

Your advisor team is managing the safety of 140 people, coalition wide. It makes things more complicated for us and potentially less safe for you if we need to manage different travel schedules for different delegates.
