So a great day yesterday now we move on to today and the only play seeing value is **Oakland**. Makes sense, we got some solid value over the weekend on dogs after faves were hot all week and the books are back to setting sharper lines. No forcing anything though just play the value where it is in the market and today it's 1 spot. Miami would probably be a play but it's Elder's first start of the year so no data to use on him. I won't exactly run to the window to bet against Atlanta since we'll have more than enough opportunities to do that over the course of the season lol. So quiet day just the 1 play with Oakland.

K Model will be posted later, as always, once umps are announced.

2 spots in the NBA that I like. Obviously the **Lakers** is one. And guess who we get as the ref tonight... my guy Scott Foster!!! If you are not familiar with Scott Foster it's simple, when he officiates a playoff game you ALWAYS bet the team that is down in the series. The team down in the series in Scott Foster officiated games win SU like 80% of the time. I think it's higher honestly but it's right in that range. They don't call him the extender for nothing lol. So I'm all for it tonight. I want the Lakers to shoot a million FTs lol.

Second game is **Orlando**. Very sketchy line movement here, Cleveland won Game 1 in blowout fashion pretty much throughout, Orlando looked like they had no chance. Line closed at 5.5 for Game 1 so you would expect this line to be around 7-7.5 for game 2. Nope it opened 5.5 and with the majority of bets and money on Cleveland this line has moved to 5. Orlando is young and I think got overwhelmed by the moment in Game 1. Got punched in the mouth early. Tonight I think they settle in a little quicker and show how talented they really are. Cleveland is no powerhouse team, they are very beatable, and I think Orlando could potentially steal a game tonight on the road.

NHL I stayed up last night and made an NHL model. Very similar to MLB just uses different inputs and some formulas but it was relatively simple to piece together. Only took a couple of hours so I figured why not, I already have the template. I will track results for the opening round to see how it goes. Obviously it's already playoff season so the data of results will be quite small but I will be interested to see how it does for the playoffs and if it's something I can use when next season comes around. Tonight it likes 2 sides. **NY ISLANDERS +195, 7.6%** (assuming Varlamov and Anderson in net) and **LA KINGS +138, 5.1%** (assuming Talbot and Skinner in net). I do take into account goalies in my model so if there is a goalie change in either game it will change the xG, however it won't change them much. I'll share the model results daily like so for the first round and if I get good results I will post it like MLB moving forward for the rest of the playoffs. If you are choosing to play these though I advise caution. I don't really know what I have here with this yet but I will share the model results with you for now since the MLB did so well right off the rip.

There we go fam. An excellent day yesterday. +6.9x on the day. Only blemish was NYM but other than that perfection. Favs were hot most the week. Opened up some solid value for us today and we capitalize.

After today both Models are up since I've been posting for you. Purple +0.68x in the 10 days I have been posting (+11.32x Total). Blue model up nice at +3.84x (+4.68x total) in the same time frame. Going forward I'll only be posting the Blue model. Purple model was only really designed for the beginning of the year while teams and pitchers get more games in and obtain enough games and ABs to accurately handicap games. We've gotten to the point where we don't need it much anymore and can no longer ignore current year stats.

After the heavy favorites days on Tuesday and Friday it is very encouraging, at least in my eyes, to have been positive over the first 10 days of sharing my model plays with you. Shows that we can still be profitable sticking to value positions in the long run and sustain bad days. Because bad days will happen. But days like today are just beautiful, especially when we are hitting on all +odds lines. So 2 awful days, 1 amazing day, and a bunch of small winning days and look, we are positive. Going to be really difficult to make consistent profits just picking and choosing when the good days and bad days are going to be and just trying to play the good days. Stay consistent and ride the waves. It will benefit you in the long run. Betting MLB is a marathon unlike any other sport. In order to capitalize on a day like yesterday you have to be willing to suffer a bad day or two.

K model is +0.74x. Nothing crazy but it is nice that there is almost 1 unit of profit while being 4-5 over the first 10 days i've been sharing results with you. Couple bad beats in there which are going to happen but being able to consistently identify SO props at +odds that have solid value should continue to net a positive result in the long term. Currently my selections based on the K Model are 4-5 (+0.74x) since I have been posting and 8-8 (+3.26x) since I have been tracking. Ok it's not 60% but at 8-8 there is still a very high ROI of 20.3%. Very impressive considering all we really have to do is hit as many as we lose to make a solid return.
