- I enjoyed listening to the discussion of apps last week. I'm sorry I couldn't call in. But I have a controversial geocaching app though that I want to share.

• Wherigos – anyone who does them at best has a love/hate relationship with them. At worst we avoid them because we all know the issues. But there is an app out there that can take away all that frustration.

•

- It's called WIGHelper. Available for iOS at least, not sure about Android. I don't even remember how I found out about it.
- In a nutshell here's what you can do once you download the cartridge, you can load it into WIGHelper and it will show you the text, zones, source code, media files, basically everything in the WIG cartridge. Which means you can jailbreak the WIG and get final coords without having to go through the full experience. It also includes a Reverse Wherigo solver. There are some caveats it doesn't work for all Wherigos. The "play anywhere" types with multiple state options can't really be broken. And some cartridges won't show the final zone (GZ). But in my experience, probably 90% can be solved with the tool.

- 1) FaceTime
- I can't believe you forgot about using FaceTime for phone a friend assistance.

  Then your friend who is out caching in a dry prairie can see you hunting in snow and try to guide you to the right place by seeing what you're seeing.

- 2) Camera
- Using the phone's camera has been indispensable when trying to see things up high or under tight spaces. Both the forward and rear cameras have uses. Kind of like using a mirror at times, but with zoom.

- 3) Go Paddeling
- This is an app for kayakers to see where put ins, take outs, parking, etc are located. Users leave their own comments and recommendations. Perfect for figuring out water caching courses.
