

Mr Cilley's students are working in their drawing class with a historical drawing technique/style called stippling. This technique uses a series of dots placed next to each other in a way that can create a strong sense of value and contrast. The closer the dots are together, the darker the image and value will be. Spread them out further and the value will be lighter. Below are some examples of stippling. In the demonstration video, Mr. Cilley is teaching the foundational skills of this technique and how to create a 3D sphere! See the video HERE.




