My name is Zorina and my daughter was trained under the Rohingya Children's Projects' tailor program. I am very happy with the support that Rohingya Childrens Projects (RCP) gives our vulnerable Rohingya women. My life was too complicated to handle the family expenses in Myanmar. It was hard to simply support us after the death of my husband. In Bangladesh, we had the same problem and things did not get better until my daughter received sewing training from RCP. Now, alhamdulillah (praise be to God), my family is on the right track thanks to the support of my daughter and her earnings. I can manage the family expenses again. I am grateful.
