This template is a guideline format to write **Original Research** for Journal of Widya Medika Junior (JWMJ) that has been adjusted to the writing style of JWMJ. Authors should follow the provided guidelines. Abstract describes the introduction, methodology, findings, and conclusions of the research. Abstract should be written in no more than 250 words transcribed in 1 (one) paragraph and there should be keywords below the Abstract consist of 3–5 specific terms that are occasionally used in the manuscript. Avoid the use of citation and abbreviation on Abstract. The page numbers of JWMJ consist of 3 to 12 pages maximum. Should there be foreign terms that have not yet been standardized, write it in *Italic*. The font type is Times New Roman, 10 pt, single spaced. All tables and figures should be separated from the text. Tables should be submitted in Microsoft Word format (.docx) and completed with figure legend. Figures should be submitted in TIFF or JPEG format with clear captions. Make sure not to change the style of this template, including font type and size, spaces, indent hanging, et cetera.

ABSTRACT

Background: Write the introduction here. **Objective:** Write the objective here. **Methods:** Write the methods here. **Results:** Write the results here. **Conclusion:** Write the conclusion here.

Keywords: 3–5 key words that identify what the research topic. (Capital letter is only used in the first keyword, separated by semicolons (;) and not stopped by a full stop after the last keyword, keywords should be arranged alphabetically).

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INTRODUCTION

Introduction contains the significances and the background of research elaborated by implementing inverted pyramid method, start from global level, national, and local. This section presents the research problem data. The introduction also mentions the urgency of the research being carried out.

The inclusion of references (studies or related research result) is by adding the name and years of the source in every sentence before full stop mark (.), in accordance with reference, for example: Strasburger et al., Research, in 2010 adolescents between 8–18 years old spent their time to access social media 7 hours a day in average.¹ For reference please use Vancouver style. When using Vancouver style/format, follow the author-number method of in-text citation. This means that sources are cited in the text using numbers in the order they appear, for example as (1), and with superscript.¹ This applies to both single and multiple authors, and to all reference sources. One complete reference for each source should appear in the reference list at the end of the paper. It is advisable to paraphrase when referencing content from another work.

The number of pages of introduction is 1–1.5 pages written in Times New Roman 12 pt 1.15–spaced. Every paragraph begins with a word protrudes into 5 digits. The final part of introduction must state the novelty and objectives of the research.

METHODS

This part explains the type of the research, location and time, population and sample, sampling technique, data collection technique, data analysis, and data presentation. Qualitative studies, such as case study, phenomenology, ethnography, et cetera, must include additional explanation regarding the description of validity checking of the research results.

Sub-title

All section on materials and methods can be written in sub-title and use sentence cases. Research that uses tools and materials must specifically write down the used tools and materials. The ethical statement must be stated, mentioning the ethics number and the granting institution.

RESULTS

Write Sub-title If Needed

The result part describes the characteristics of research subjects, univariate analysis, bivariate analysis, and multivariate analysis (if any). In this part, the author is allowed to present tables and figures in which the writing style must be in accordance with writing guidelines.

DISCUSSION

The interpretation of research result is written in form of narrative followed by the discussions that collaborates the research results with the corresponding theories. The limitation of research should be mentioned.

CONCLUSION

Conclusion consist of brief summary of the description of the results according to the objectives of the study. Suggestion is arranged based on the findings of the study that has been scrutinized on the discussion. Suggestion may refer to practical actions, development of new theories, and/or further research. The paragraph begins with a word protrudes into 5 digits and must not use bullet or numbering. Conclusion and suggestion are written within 1 paragraph.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT

Acknowledgements of people, grants, funds, etc should be placed in a separate section not numbered at the very end of the paper.

Using Vancouver Style. The minimal number of references should be 20, and 80% of them should be up to date (published during the last 10 years). References from journals are preferred, at least 80%. Authors is recommended to use reference management software.
