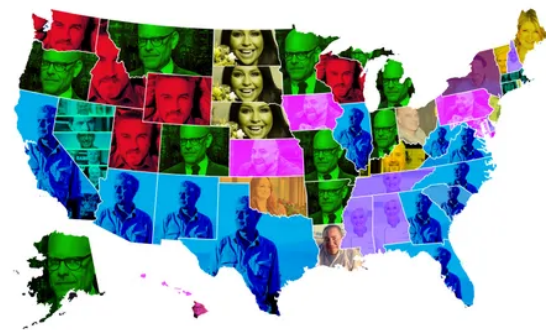

This is a visual research project of a celebrity chef. The foldable you create about your celebrity chef will inform others about that chef's contributions to the food world.	Research your celebrity chef. The following is a list of questions about the chef that must be included in your project. <i>*Even if your chef does not meet criteria listed, please make note of that in your presentation to receive full credit!</i> • Birth date • Where were they born? • Where did they go to culinary school or training? • Where has your Chef worked? • What inspired or influenced them to become a chef/cook? • What food nationality do they focus on? • Describe your chefs preferred type of cooking/food types. • What is their claim to fame (what are they most known for)? • Identify any books they've written • Identify any TV shows they've been on are currently on • Any restaurants they own or founded, names and locations • Any awards that your chef have received/won. • Additional "Fun Facts" about your chef (minimum of 3) • A quote from this person
Apply	Your Task
Students will be creating a pop up foldable that will be presented to the class about a celebrity chef of their choice.	Create a foldable to present about your chef. Step 1: Person Template - Draw a picture or print a picture of the chef and attach it. Step 2: Title the Foldable with your Chef's Name at the top of the foldable. Step 3: Include the following information that you have researched about your chef on the foldable. <i>(suggestions - use bubbles to highlight the following information~ie. Top left bubble for the birth date and location of birth, Bottom left to bubble for the quote, top right bubble for where the chef went to school or had training and the food they are known for and bottom right bubble of name of restaurants and/or tv shows.)</i> • Birth date and where were they born • Quote from the chef

- Write where the chef went to school or had training and the type of food they are known for.

Step 4: Write a summary of all the research, but focus on the information that was not included in step 3. The summary is suggested to go at the bottom of the foldable.

Step 5: Head your Project on the back.
