October 9, 2019 Board Minutes

The board meeting of the HLV Community School District was held on October, 2019, at 5:00 p.m. President Hollopeter called the meeting to order.

Roll call resulted in board members Hollopeter, Blomme, Doran, and Kolesar being present, a quorum was declared. Hawkins was absent. Also present were Superintendent Hohensee, Cory Lahndorf and Lori McClenathan.

Kolesar read the Mission Statement "Teaching our Youth of Today to be Leaders of Tomorrow". Hollopeter then read the President's Statement.

Doran motioned to approve the consent agenda items, which included approval of the previous meeting minutes, approval of current bills and additional bills, approval of financial reports, facility use requests, open enrollment request, resignations from Jenn Bullers, paraeducator, employment offers to Denny Claeys, SPED Bus Driver, Billie Calderwood and Stacy Axmear, CO- HR Personnel seconded by Blomme, unanimously adopted.

There was a discussion on the Voted PPEL that will be on the ballot November 5. Hohensee stated there will be an article placed in the Warrior Words, on website, and newspaper.

Motion by Doran to approve the second reading of policies 203 & 206.2, seconded by Kolesar, unanimously adopted.

Motion by Kolesar to approve the second reading of policy 307, seconded by Blomme, unanimously adopted.

Kolesar motioned to approve the second reading of policy 501.5 & 505.5, seconded by Doran, unanimously adopted.

Blomme motioned to approve the second reading of policy 603.1, seconded by Kolesar, unanimously adopted.

Under the Superintendent's report, Hohensee presented his October updated schedule. Hohensee remarked there have been several positive comments from the community regarding track improvements. Review of policy sections 300 and 400 will start in December with approvals in January. The IASB Convention will be held November 20-22, main day is November 21, for any members wanting to attend. The PHT installed new backboards on the basketball court on the playground and painted lines on the new concrete on playground for various activities. Hohensee praised the PHT for assisting with many facility improvements. The Employee Relations Conference will be held on October 17 for any members interested in attending.

Principal Lahndorf commented the end of the first quarter is October 17th. Parent – Teacher conferences will be held on October 29-30. The first Washington DC fundraiser was recently completed.

Guidance Counselor Robison commented Juniors will take the PSAT test next week. Freshman recently visited Victor Manufacturing , Sophomores- Iowa Mold, and Junior/Seniors visited Kinze Manufacturing. These fieldtrips were to expose high school students to various tech jobs.
