Since the earliest days, Texas PTA leaders and members have sought to fulfill our mission to make every child's potential a reality by engaging and empowering families and communities to advocate for all children.

As such, Texas PTA is proud to offer the opportunity to recognize and celebrate the advocacy efforts of Local PTAs, Council PTAs, and Students through the prestigious Advocacy Impact Awards. The award categories and examples are listed below.

**Earn the Digital Badge:** All eligible applicants will receive a digital badge or certificate and be celebrated on the Texas PTA website to honor their advocacy efforts.

**Council PTAs:** complete an activity from at least 3 listed categories.

**Local PTAs:** complete an activity from at least 2 listed categories.

**Students:** earn a digital certificate after completing an activity from at least 1 category.

**Outstanding Advocacy Impact Awards:** One outstanding submission from each group above will be recognized on stage at LAUNCH. *Local and Council PTAs must be in Good Standing to be eligible for the Outstanding Advocacy Impact Award.*
