Guest Speaker: Horizon Bank, Josh Shelly VP District Mgr. Territory from Columbus to Marion Indiana. The bank will be located at 38th Arlington, this is phase one and plans on opening by the second quarter of next year 2026. Phase two will consist of low-income housing in the future. The bank wants to have an impact on the community; there will be a community space available to have meetings after business hours and on weekends this space can accommodate up to twenty people. A variety of accounts will be offered, checking, savings, business accounts etc. The banks want to help people with checking accounts to manage their money and stop going to pay here loan places. It is called Fresh Start checking account, giving people a second chance.

The bank has various loans such as: Home Pride Plus Loans, Down payment assistance from IHVDA, Launch Down Payment Assistance, Home Boost and other information on loans.

Neighbors have issues with people that live on each side of him, neighbor driving on his side of property what can be done. IMPD says they can come out to neighbors with medication.

The neighbor wants to know what can be done about the light at 38th and Shadeland, it takes a very long time to change and traffic backs up. IMPD cannot do anything about this issue, Mr. Campbell says this will or has been addressed with DOT.

Neighbor Sandra: 42nd and Arlington these apartments have been empty for ten years plus; an investor brought them and is currently doing renovation. These apartments were a twelve-unit building, but they are making it an eighteen-unit building, six of the units will be efficient. Sandra is concerned by the private fencing that went up, someone stole some of the supplies, so the developer finished the part that wasn't six feet with a four feet picket fence. It looks very odd.

Garrett: It has been reported beware of individuals running up on you outside of the store parking lot and stealing your food items.

Prop 50: there are seven republican congressional seats and two democratic congressional seats. Talks about redistricting, changing the maps during mid-term instead of every ten years. District 7 is an all-black district, this is being watched closely,

we are dealing with different governments. People have been asked to write letters to the senators, reach out to representatives that don't represent us.

Additional notes from James Campbell, attended a meeting regarding the vacant buildings on East 38th Street, we need to eliminate some and encourage businesses to move in and build up this area. Dr. Kenneth Sullivan Jr. Pastor of New Directions Church, Brian Shobe, Pastor of Shiloh Missionary Baptist Church on East 38th street and other individual business owners on 38th street.
