

MISSION 1: Outside — The Heart of the Cemetery (Choose 3)

#5 Abraham Lincoln Tablet - across from the admin building.	Reflect: Why do you think a tablet honoring Abraham Lincoln is here at a veterans' cemetery?	
#7 Chapel - across from the Memorial Walkway	Observe: On the mural, find & describe one important feature of NH - what is it?	
#6.A Circle of Flags - at the 'bowl' in front of the Historical Walkway	List the six seals on the stones at the circle of flags. What three flags are flying in the circle of flags?
