### **NEW BUSINESS**

#### • Rose City Golf Course Trail

- O Project was on hold due to departure of PM. We have asked to be included in design process. (see email from Kelly for response from new PM)
- O Ed Gorman—long term plan is to tie in with 72<sup>nd</sup> ave greenway. Ed presents background of the project. Multi-use trail on east side of 72<sup>nd</sup>. Plans for the trails (to be ADA) have been in the works for years. Funds to come from ODOT and PBOT going back to 2015 stated plans. Metro also provided a \$2M grant. PBOT awarded the project for \$2.9M to a contractor.
- O Golf trail and 72<sup>nd</sup> drive are separate projects with some crossover.
- O Was originally presented as a nature trail. Ed thinks new proposed trail to get students to McDaniel and from Ellington is redundant.
- O Ed presented a drawing proposing a multi-use path coming off of 72<sup>nd</sup>, veering to right heading north. This would provide access to Roseway Heights and McDaniel.
- O Ed and Sharron met with Mark Jamison from Parks Bureau, talked for one hour about short and long-term plan. Mark said he would maintain outreach to NAs.

- O Ed claims closing 72<sup>nd</sup> ave one way violates PBOT's connectivity policy (goes beyond 2600-plus feet distance).
- Zachary is working on scheduling a walk through, and will hopefully learn more about process
- o Ed is hoping for more public engagement before the project moves forward
- o PBOT is going to put jersey barriers on 72<sup>nd</sup> where the Road Closed sign was removed.
- Next steps: Kelly to call Allison Stoll and connect with neighboring NAs. Check into committee that the Board discussed.
- Ed is going to add his presentation and support docs to the meeting folder for LUTC

Sharron is talking to Ellington people about setting up Food Pantry

#### 64th & Brazee

Concrete planters have been installed and need adjusting and reflectors

We can paint if we like. They are currently yellow.

Planting will happen in Spring. Vicky is leading effort.
